

Many rides and attractions at Fun Land of Fredericksburg are dynamic and thrilling. There are inherent risks in riding any amusement ride. If you choose to ride, you accept all of these risks. Restrictions for guests of larger size (height or weight) are posted at certain rides. Guests with disabilities should refer to our Ride Admission Policy available at Guest Services. Participate responsibly. You should be in good health to ride safely. You know your physical conditions and limitations, Fun Land of Fredericksburg does not. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **DO NOT RIDE!** All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened and tightened properly to allow guests to ride.

Welcome to Fun Land of Fredericksburg!

We are excited to be able to spend the day with you! We are committed to providing our guests with a safe environment and we want our guests to have a safe and enjoyable day. We are continually striving to improve our facilities. If you have a suggestion for an improvement or have questions not answered in this brochure, please stop at Guest Services or ask to have a manager paged for you.

Many amusement park rides incorporate safety systems designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. These safety systems may place restrictions on the ability of an individual to safely experience the ride. Guests of larger or smaller size, guests who have a history of heart, back or neck trouble, pregnant women, people who have had recent surgery, or people with casts, braces, restrictive devices or disabilities may not be safely accommodated by these systems. For example, height requirements are based on the size needed for the safety restraints to function properly and the level of maturity usually associated with a certain height.

Fun Land of Fredericksburg's Rider Screening Policy has been developed based off careful review of the manufacturer's recommendations and requirements, normal and emergency operating conditions of the attractions, and the years of experience across the industry that our management team has acquired. Our goal is to be able to provide each guest the chance to participate and enjoy each ride and attraction we have to offer while taking into consideration the ability of each person to endure the dynamics of the ride without risking injury to that person or others around them.

If you feel that you or a member of your party may be affected by this policy, you are more than welcome to ask for a manager to come speak with you and provide a list of rides and attractions that you can safely enjoy. The manager will provide you with a Ride Access Slip that will assist our Attractions Operators in ensuring you have a wonderful visit with us.

Safety Information

Virginia State Law Code 59.7-520 requires all riders to obey all warnings and directions and behave in a manner that will not cause or contribute to injuring themselves or others. Riders shall report all injuries before leaving.

While all amusement attractions have associated risks, certain individuals are at increased risk for injury from these attractions. Carefully watch our rides and attractions to see if you or anyone in your group can safely participate. We reserve the right to deny access to a ride or attraction to anyone we feel may not be able to safely participate or may be a hazard to other riders. A Safety Guide sign is posted at every ride entrance. These signs provide height requirements, health restrictions, and special instructions regarding the ride. Please review these signs prior to participating on those rides and attractions and be sure to follow all posted and operator rules and restrictions.

In general, all riders should be in good health and free from any conditions known or unknown that might be aggravated by riding. If you have any doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride, we urge you to consult with our managers. Remember, if you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **DO NOT PARTICIPATE.**

Generally, guests must have the ability to brace themselves upright in the seat and support their head and neck during the ride movements. Riders using wheelchairs will have to transfer from their wheelchair to the ride unit by themselves

or assisted by a member of their group in order to be able to ride. You should plan your visit with someone who can physically help you when necessary.

As a rider, you are responsible for your own safety. Please read this guide and all instructional signage before riding. Listen to and follow all operator instructions. Any person who intentionally removes a safety restraint, violates a park safety policy, or appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be removed from the park without refund. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER UNAUTHORIZED AREAS TO RETRIEVE LOST ARTICLES.** You may be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area.

Before riding, please note all safety warnings for each ride. In general:

- Face forward and remain seated in an upright position with your back and shoulders against the seat back and hold on until the ride comes to a complete stop.
- All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses, and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened, and tightened at all times.
- Because of the forces created on most of our rides and attractions, backpacks, purses, electronics, stuffed animals and other loose items are not permitted while riding. Glasses must be secured. Smaller items may be secured in cargo pockets as long as they do not interfere with the restraint system. In addition, smaller items may be left with a non-rider. Fun Land of Fredericksburg is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles. You are responsible for your personal property.
- No picture taking or cell phone usage while riding.
- Keep all of your body inside the ride unit at all times.
- Shirt, shoes, and shorts/pants are required on all rides and attractions.
- Some attractions may require additional wardrobe restrictions, such as hooded sweatshirts, boots,
- Finish food and drink before boarding.

Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is only permitted in the designated smoking area (Gazebo located behind Round Up)

Evacuations

Evacuations may be required due to such causes as a mechanical problem, weather conditions, or a power outage. If an evacuation is required, guests may need to maneuver from the highest point of the ride, and down steeply inclined walkways and ride tracks. Ride units may also stop at the on the ride course due to mechanical reasons. Remain seated until given instructions.

If an evacuation from a ride/attraction is required, for safety reasons, we may evacuate ambulatory guests prior to evacuating those guests using wheelchairs. If so, you accept any risk due to delayed evacuation of if we need to physically lift or lower you.

Guests of a Larger Size

All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses, and seatbelts must be positioned and fastened properly to allow guests to ride. Due to rider restraint system requirements, guests of larger size may not be accommodated on some of our rides.

Our larger guests may experience difficulty on Clip 'n Climb, Frog Hopper, Spin Out, and Twist N Shout. Maximum and minimum weight limits can be found under the individual rides in this guide and on the Safety Guide Signs at the entrance to rides with restrictions. If you are concerned whether or not you can be accommodated safely on a ride, you may approach any ride attendant or manager and they will give you the opportunity to test out the ride unit and restraints before you wait through the line.

Health Restrictions



Each ride is evaluated against 5 primary health restrictions. These restrictions are:

- Recent Surgery
- Heart Trouble/High Blood Pressure
- Neck Trouble
- Back Trouble
- Pregnancy

Guests with a history of recent surgery, heart trouble, high blood pressure, neck trouble, back trouble, or any other condition that may be aggravated by riding, or who are pregnant, should carefully heed all warning signs at each ride entrance. If you are in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride or would like more rider information, please review the information for each attraction in this guide or review the Safety Guides posted at each ride entrance.

Height Requirements

Height requirements and specific rider instructions are posted at the entrance to each attraction. Children may be measured at any ride of the appropriate height level.

For the safety of your child, a standard play shoe which does not contribute excessively to the child's height is required. For example, a child is not permitted to wear platform shoes to help meet a height requirement.

Loose Articles

The rides and attractions at Fun Land of Fredericksburg cannot accommodate loose articles including cell phones, glasses, hats, cameras, stuffed animals, purses, backpacks, umbrellas, beverage containers, electronic devices, etc. Items must be safely secured in cargo pockets, in a bin on the ride platform, or with a non-rider. Fun Land of Fredericksburg is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items. Extra or bulky clothing, backpacks and anything else that could potentially be between the rider and the restraint will not be allowed. The restraint mechanism must be secured snugly against the rider's body. For safety reasons, using a cell phone, taking pictures and filming on rides is prohibited. Your hands must be free to hold on during the ride; therefore, nothing can be in your hands while riding. Additionally, hats are not allowed on any rides.

Glasses must be secured on all rides.

Hearing devices or any other electronic devices may be damaged by water. Please take the necessary steps to protect such items.

Lost Articles

Operators cannot be responsible for items lost, stolen, or damaged while riding. All items found at Fun Land of Fredericksburg are turned in to Lost and Found. If you lose an article on a ride, we will search for the article as soon as is practical, but in order to keep the ride in operation an immediate search may not be possible. If an item is not found, please visit Guest Services to fill out a form or call us at 540-785-6700 and speak to the operator. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER UNAUTHORIZED AREAS TO RETRIEVE LOST ARTICLES. You may be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area.**

Oxygen Tanks

Due to the dynamic nature of rides, oxygen tanks are generally not permitted on most rides.

Photosensitivity / Strobe Lighting

Many attractions utilize special effects including strobe lighting and specialty ride lights that may impact guests with

certain medical conditions. Attractions utilizing these effects include; Laser Tag, XD Theater, Twist N Shout, Spin Out, Hologate, Arcade Floor

Pregnancy

Pregnant women are prohibited from participating on all rides and attractions at Fun Land of Fredericksburg.

Proper Attire

Most rides require proper riding attire including shirts and shoes. Shirts and shoes are required in queues and all park pathways. For your safety, loose clothing (including scarves and other free-flowing clothing), must be significantly secured or removed to prevent any interference with the ride restraint system. To participate on the Clip 'n Climb climbing challenges, guests must wear closed toe/closed heel rubber sole shoes. Boots of any kind are not permitted. Hoodies and scarfs are strictly prohibited as they may pose a choking hazard. Helmets are only permitted on the "Stairway to Heaven" climbing challenge.

Prosthetics

Guests with any type of prosthesis should not ride unless they can ensure the device is properly secured and will remain in place during the ride. All riders must be able to maintain the proper riding positioning. Additionally, prosthetic devices with exposed metal parts are not permitted on the Fun Slide and Clip 'n Climb elements. Guests should ask a manager prior to riding to ensure a safe riding experience.

Prosthetics are NOT allowed on the following:

- Round Up (due to the forces of the attraction)
- Tubs of Fun and Twist N Shout (Arm prosthetics are not allowed due to the nature of the ride)

Rider Criteria

Fun Land of Fredericksburg's Rider Screening Policy is designed to allow our guests to participate in the enjoyment of our facility as much as possible. The policy was developed by analyzing the physical and mental attributes required to safely participate on each ride and attraction. It is our policy to allow anyone to ride who meets all these requirements and is not a hazard to himself or others. We continue to evaluate and update our Rider Screening Policy as necessary.

Ability to exhibit independent seated postural control under the dynamic conditions of the ride. *The guest must have the body and spinal control to sit upright without the aid of other people or devices. The guest must also have sufficient muscle control to support their head, neck and upper torso during the course of the ride, including the dynamic motion of the ride.*

Appropriate center of gravity. *The guest's body must have the appropriate weight distribution for that ride.*

Ability to hold on with one functioning arm. *A functioning arm is an upper extremity or prosthesis exhibiting good grip control, the ability to brace, and enough strength to allow the guest to maintain the proper riding position throughout the duration of the ride. Any arm prosthesis must remain properly secured under*

the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthetics.

Ability to hold on with two functioning arms. *Ability to hold on with two functioning arms as defined above.*

Ability to brace self with one functioning leg. *Guests must have one functioning leg to be used for bracing the body during the course of the ride. A functioning leg may be a normal leg or a prosthesis which can be used for bracing. Any leg prosthesis must remain properly secured under the dynamic forces of the ride. Due to manufacturer requirements, some rides may exclude prosthetics.*

Ability to brace self with two functioning legs. *Guests must have two functioning legs to be used for bracing the body during the course of the ride and maintaining balance when entering and exiting a ride unit. A functioning leg may be a normal leg or a prosthesis.*

Minimum of two functioning extremities. *Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities (two legs, two arms, or one arm and one leg) to brace themselves during the ride and assist in entering and exiting the ride unit.*

Minimum of three functioning extremities. *Guests must have a minimum of three functioning extremities (two legs and one arm or two arms and one leg) to brace themselves (with tripod bracing) during the ride.*

Ability to enter/exit the attraction within specified parameters without endangering self or others. *Guests must be able to enter and exit the ride without jeopardizing themselves or others and to assist with their own evacuation, if necessary. This may include special arrangements such as entering through the attraction exit or having someone aid you in boarding. For the safety of our cast members and guests, ride operators are instructed not to perform any lifting of guests.*

Appropriate observed behavior.

Guest demonstrates appropriate observed behavior indicating a willingness and ability to participate and/or follow rider requirements. Appropriate observed behavior may include, but not be limited to maintaining proper riding position, attention and compliance to safety instructions, proper use of all ride safety equipment and willingness to participate.

Guests have a duty to:

- exercise good judgment
- act in a responsible manner while using amusement rides
- obey all warnings prior to and during participation
- not participate while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- properly use all ride safety equipment provided.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND SERVICES

Our goal is to make Fun Land of Fredericksburg a fun and exciting place for everyone. Should you find that you need assistance at any point during your visit, please do not hesitate to ask any one of our cast members. They will be happy to assist you in any way needed to make your visit more enjoyable. Listed below is a list of the services we offer. Please feel free to suggest areas in which we might improve in the future.

First Aid

If there is a need for bandages or small first aid supplies, please see one of our cast members. First Aid supplies are located in the Café and out near the Thunder 104.5 Speedway shop. For medical emergencies, please ask for a manager and we will activate our emergency action plan to get you the treatment you require. AED's are placed in the Café lobby as well as in the mechanic shop next to Thunder 104.5 Speedway.

Parking

Parking for guests with disabilities is provided in the parking lot in the first two spots of each row next to the building. Proper vehicle identification must be displayed.

Restrooms

Restrooms are available next to the Laser Tag arena as well as a family restroom behind the Twist N Shout coaster near the party rooms.

Service Animals

Service animals (limited guide dogs and miniature ponies) are welcome at Fun Land of Fredericksburg but must always be physically controlled on a leash or harness. Due to the nature of our rides and attractions, service animals must remain with a non-riding member of the guest's party. Fun Land of Fredericksburg's cast members are not permitted to take control of service animals. Guests whose service animal demonstrates aggressive actions towards our guests or cast members will be directed to remove the animal from the park. Limit one service animal per guest.

RIDES

The following descriptions are designed to give you information on the type of actions caused by various rides. Each of the following attractions will identify the restrictions according to the criteria itemized above. **In order to participate on most attractions, guests must have seated postural control, appropriate center of gravity, appropriate observed behavior, and the ability to enter and exit the ride safely.** Specific exceptions or qualifications to those four criteria will be noted in the information provided below.

Clip ‘n Climb: 

Height Requirement - 36” tall to participate
36” to 58” must be accompanied by an adult

Weight Restriction - Participants must not exceed 275lbs in total weight

Attraction Description - This attraction features 9 different climbing challenges with varying elements designed to present a fun and exciting climbing experience

Restraint Design - Guests are suited up in full-body harnesses that feature shoulder straps and leg loops as well as a waist belt (adults)/chest strap (juniors). They are tethered to each element by means of a self-locking auto-belay system.

Rider Criteria - Guests must be able to stand, walk, and climb with no assistance. Guests with leg, foot, arm, or hand casts may not participate. Guests with hard braces may not participate. Upper and lower extremities must be of sufficient length to remain contained and restrained in the shoulder straps and leg loops.

Go Kart Driver: 

Height Requirement – 46” to 57” to drive Naskart Rookies, 58” to drive Naskart adult, 60” to drive Thunder 104.5 Speedway karts. Drivers of Passengers must present a valid Driver’s License to be able to drive.

Attraction Descriptions – Naskart Track gives two different racing experiences for the young and old on a oval-shaped track. Thunder 104.5 Speedway gives Virginia’s first multi-level go karting experience with changes in direction, elevation and speed. Both tracks feature gas-powered, operator-controlled go karts with speeds not exceeding 19 MPH.

Restraint Design – All go karts feature a single-clasping harness with two shoulder straps and one lap strap that are adjustable.

Rider Criteria - Drivers must have four functioning extremities; two functioning arms/hands and two functioning legs/feet. Drivers must exhibit sufficient visual acuity to operate the car safely. Drivers also need to be able to steer the car, hold on to the steering wheel with both hands, and use both feet to operate the brake and gas pedals. Guests with a cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone, full arm cast, braced arm cast, or full leg cast are not permitted to ride.

Go Kart Passenger: 

Height Requirement – 40” tall or taller and the Driver must present a valid Driver’s License to the operator.

Attraction Description – Please see “Attraction Description” under “Go Kart Driver”

Restraint Design – Please see “Restraint Design” under “Go Kart Driver”

Rider Criteria - Passengers must have at least one functioning arm and sufficient lower extremities to ensure the ride restraint system adequately restrains them. Guests with a cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone, full arm cast, braced arm cast, or full leg cast are not permitted to ride.

Frog Hopper: 

Height Requirement - 36” tall to participate

Weight Restriction - Entire load of passengers may not exceed 700lbs

Attraction Description - a miniature drop tower allowing guests to experience quick changes in elevation as the unit ascends and descends the tower.

Restraint Design - This attraction features a single lap bar that lowers over the passengers’ laps.

Rider Criteria - Ability to exhibit independent seated postural control and center of gravity under the dynamic conditions of the ride. Ability to hold on with (at least) one functioning arm and brace oneself. Minimum of 2 functioning legs AND 1 functioning arm if the guest has a normal center of gravity and the lower extremities are sufficiently strong to support weight against the restraint under dynamic conditions of the ride. Amputation must be at the knee or below. Ability to enter/exit ride within specified parameters without endangering self or others.

Fun Slide: 

Height Requirement – Guests under 42” in height must be accompanied by an adult

Attraction Description - A Giant Fun Slide featuring 3 individual lanes and 2 air-time hills finishing on a long level stretch at the bottom

Restraint Design – Guests are seated in a burlap sack with a foot pocket sewn into the bottom of it

Rider Criteria - Guests must be able to maintain an upright position with their legs straightened out in front of them and their feet in the lower pocket of the sack. Hard, metallic braces are not allowed. Guests must also be able to climb the stairway of the slide to participate.

Mini Ferris Wheel: 

Height Requirement – Between 32” and 54” to ride

Weight Restriction – Riders may not exceed a total of 100lbs between the two in one gondola.

Attraction Description - a ride where gondolas are mounted on a wheel that spins in a forward motion creating changes in elevation.

Restraint Design – Gondolas feature a lap chain that is connected across both laps of passengers.

Rider Criteria - Guests must have sufficient lower extremities to ensure the ride restraint system adequately restrains them

Round Up: 

Height Requirement – 46” tall to ride

Attraction Description - a centrifuge stile ride that spins riders up to a high speed and elevates on a hydraulic driven arm before lowering them back down and slowing back down.

Restraint Design – Round Up features a single chain per position to prevent passengers from walking out of their stall during the ride cycle.

Ride Criteria - Guests must have a minimum of 3 functioning extremities; one functioning arm and two functioning legs. Guests must be able to stand unassisted for the duration of the ride with their feet inside the designated rider area, backs and heads against the pad, and legs straight throughout. Due to the forces of the ride, prosthetics are not permitted

Scrambler: 

Height Requirement – 36” tall to ride, 36”-48” must be accompanied by a guest that is at least 48” tall or taller

Attraction Description - a ride where rotating cars are mounted on counter-rotating arms. The ride manufactured by Eli Bridge, produces strong accelerations while changing forces and directions rapidly.

Restraint Design – Scrambler features a seat belt that goes across the laps of up to 3 passengers in a tub and a door that closes with a handlebar attached for holding on and bracing.

Ride Criteria - Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities; one functioning arm and one functioning leg. Two functioning arms sufficient instead of one functioning arm and one functioning leg if the guest has normal center of gravity and lower extremities are sufficiently strong to support weight against the restraint under dynamic conditions of the ride. Amputations must be at the knee or below. Guests may have two functioning legs instead of one functioning arm and one functioning leg. Guests with cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone or braced arm cast are not permitted to ride.

Spin Out: 

Height Requirement – 44” tall to participate

Attraction Description - electric zero-turn vehicles driven by dual control levers allowing vehicles to move forward, reverse, and spin in any direction. Vehicles are single-seated

Restraint Design – Spin Out features a single chest strap that is positioned over the guest’s chest and under both arms.

Ride Criteria - Guests must have two functioning arms/hands in order to participate (vehicle is controlled by two directional control levers on either side of the guest).

Guests must be able to maintain a upright seated position and lower extremities must be sufficiently strong to be able to stabilize under dynamic conditions of the ride. Guests with a cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone, or braced arm cast are not permitted to ride.

Tilt-A-Whirl: 

Height Requirement – 36” tall to ride, 36”-48” must be accompanied by a guest that is at least 48” tall or taller

Attraction Description - a ride where rotating cars are mounted on a rotating platform that makes slight changes in elevation to spin the cars

Restraint Design – Tilt-A-Whirl features a single handle for the entire tub that serves only as a handle to hold on to and brace.

Ride Criteria - Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities; one functioning arm and one functioning leg. Two functioning arms are sufficient instead of one functioning arm and one functioning leg if the guest has normal center of gravity and lower extremities are sufficiently strong to support weight under dynamic conditions of the ride. Amputations must be at the knee or below. Guests may have two functioning legs instead of one functioning arm and one functioning leg. Guests with cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone or braced arm cast are not permitted to ride.

Tubs of Fun: 

Height Requirement – 30” tall to ride, 30”-42” must be accompanied by a guest that is at least 42” tall or taller and considered a supervising companion

Attraction Description - a spinning teacup ride where individual tubs spin on arms that go around in a circle. Guests may also spin their car through use of a wheel in the center of the car.

Restraint Design – While not featuring any restraints for the passengers, each tub features a single entrance/exit door with a chain clip

Ride Criteria - Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities; one functioning arm (excluding prosthesis) and one functioning leg. Guests with a cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone, full arm cast, or braced arm cast are not permitted to ride.

Twist N Shout: 

Height Requirement – 36” tall to ride, 36”-48” must be accompanied by a guest that is at least 48” tall or taller, guests taller than 77” are not allowed to ride

Weight Restriction: Passengers may not exceed 243lbs individually

Attraction Description - a “figure 8” steel spinning coaster where riders experience changes in elevation and speed.

Restraint Design – individual lap bars with a seatbelt that attaches to the seat between the guest’s legs

Ride Criteria - Guests must have a minimum of three functioning extremities; one functioning arm (excluding prosthesis) and two functioning legs. Lower extremities must

be sufficiently strong to support weight against the restraint under dynamic conditions of the ride. Amputation must be at the knee or below. Guests must be able to exhibit independent seated postural control under the dynamic conditions of the ride as well as maintaining a center of gravity.

Guests with casts and/or bandages that extend beyond the elbow or knee are not allowed to ride as they will need the ability to bend their knees and elbows.

Guests with casts or bandages on the upper thighs or abdomen may not participate as it may interfere with the restraint system or the restraint system may cause more harm to healing body parts. Guests with a cervical collar, neck brace, broken collar bone, or braced arm cast are not permitted to ride.

XD Theater: 

Height Requirement – 40” tall to participate

Weight Restriction: Passengers may not exceed 350lbs individually

Attraction Description – A multi-dimensional experience that contains a 3D film, blasters, motion seats, and fans/lighting effects

Restraint Design – individual seat belts that go across the guest'

Ride Criteria - Guests must be able to maintain their center of Gravity while sitting upright in the seat.
